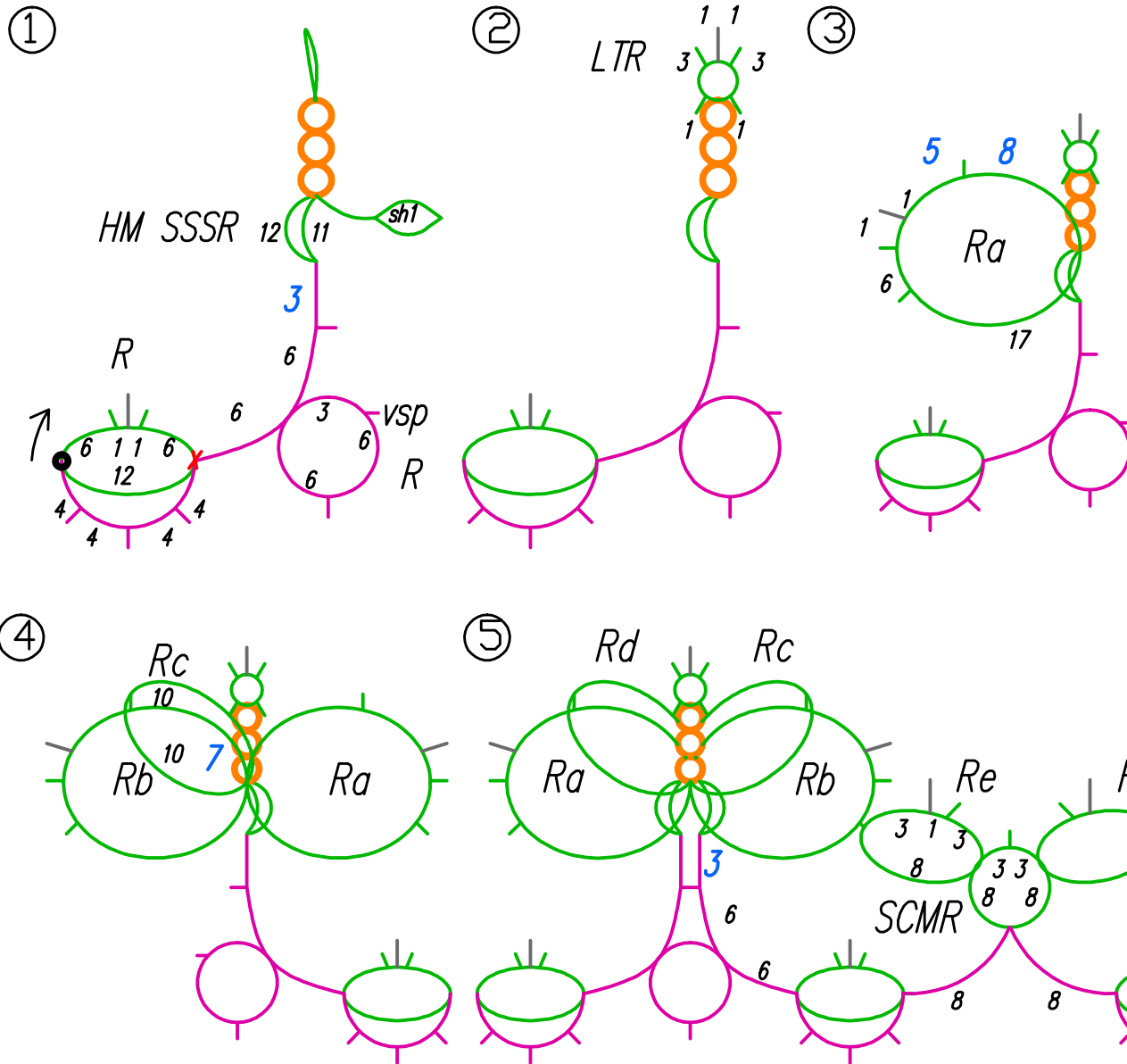


Edging "Flowers"



Abbreviations and colours:

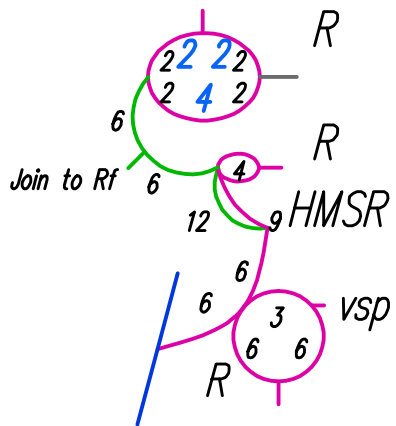
sh1 - shuttle 1 - green lines
 sh2 - shuttle 2 - pink lines
 long picots - grey lines
 beads - orange circles
 vsp - very small picot
 R - ring (a, b, c, d - tating order)
 x - locking join
 blue numbers - number of double double knots
 HM SSSR - half moon single shuttle split ring
 LTR - loop tatted ring
 RW - reverse work
 SCMR - self-closing mock ring
 /- the next picture begins from this point
 HMSR - half moon split ring

Notes:

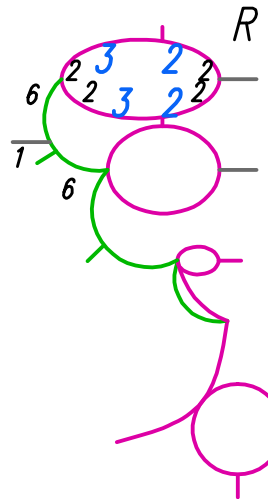
- ① Add 3 beads to the loop made of sh1 thread
- ② Make LTR using this loop
- ④ RW, make the following 3 rings from the same point in front of the beaded element (from the backside of the edging the beads will not be seen). Join Rc with Rb and with LTR (backward join), join Rd with LTR and with Ra (backward join)
- ⑤ RW, make a loop with sh1 thread, turn it once round the thread between Ra and HM SSSR, pass sh1 through the loop and tighten.

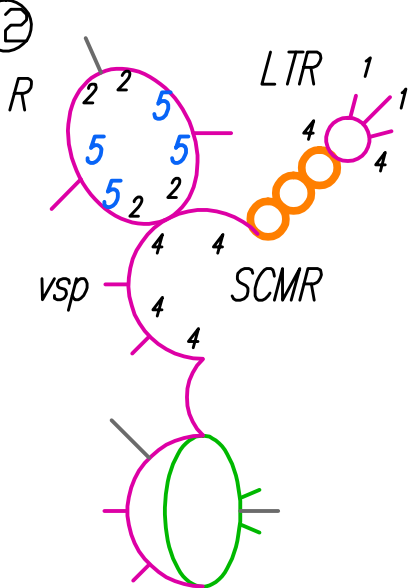
Add one bead to each long picot before joining to the opposite ring. Make a loop with sh2 thread, turn it once round the base of the 1st HMSR, pass sh2 through the loop and tighten.

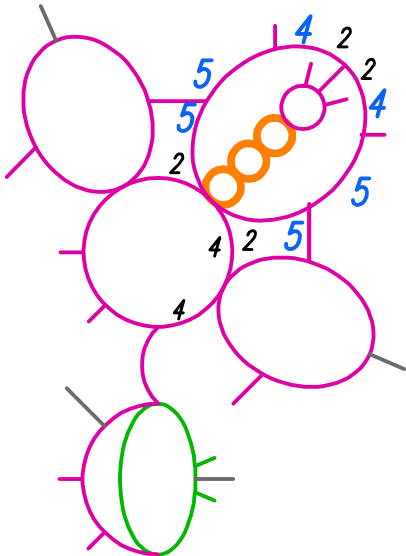

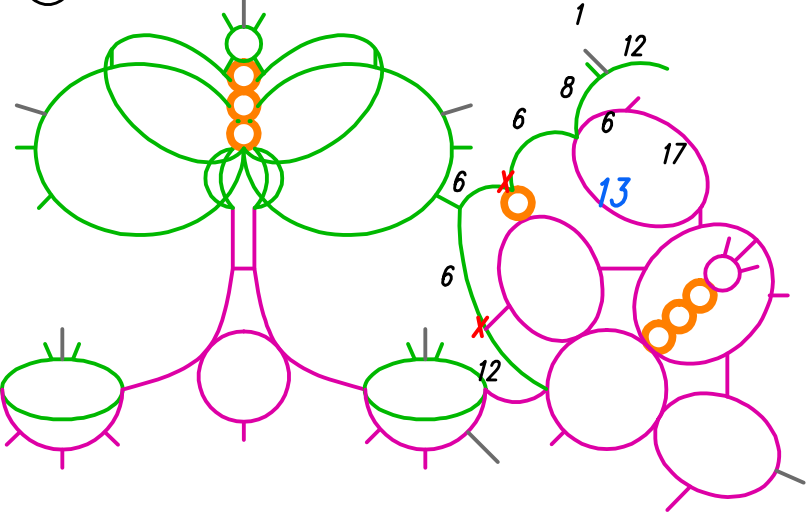

RW, begin SCMR

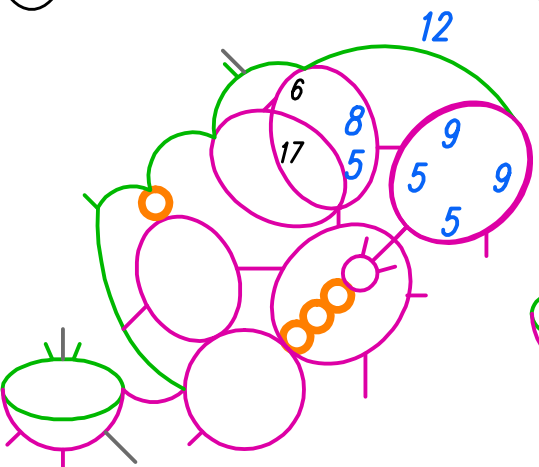
