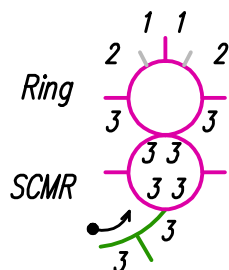
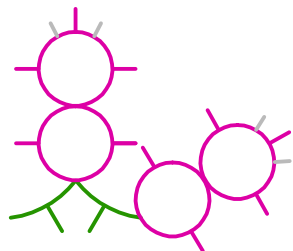


# Snowflakes I and II

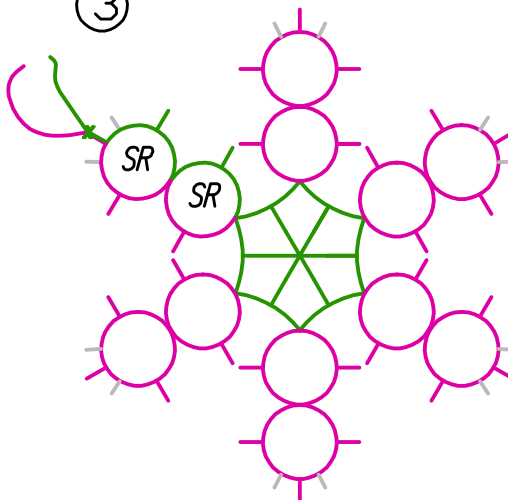

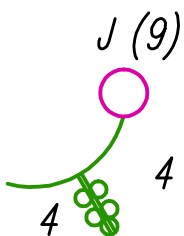

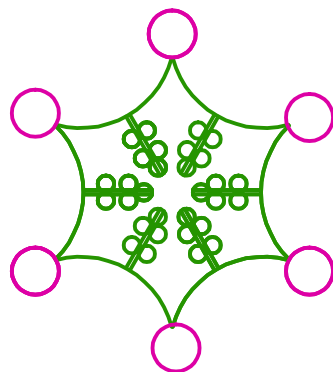

## Abbreviations and colours:

sh1 – shuttle 1 – green lines

sh2 – shuttle 2 – pink lines

SCMR – self-closing mock ring

SR – split ring

J (n) – Josephine knot (number of half stitches)

## Notes:

① Picots in grey are medium picots, all others – long.

② Do not join picots on chains yet.

③ Picot on the last chain: lead the crochet through all previously made picots in one movement and pull sh1 thread making a loop, pass sh1 through this loop, tighten, but be attentive to leave enough thread before tightening (it's the 1st half of the picot) and also before completing chain (the 2nd half of the picot).

In order to use sh thread for hanging the snowflake, make the last segment consisting of 2 SRs, tie knot representing the last picot.

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Add 30 beads to sh1 thread before tatting.  
Add 5 beads to each picot.
