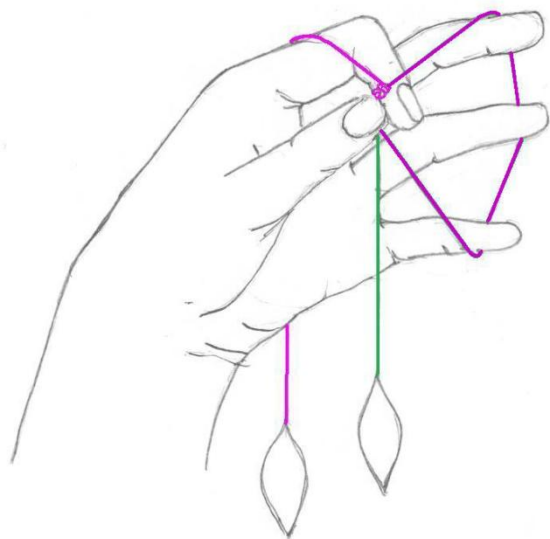
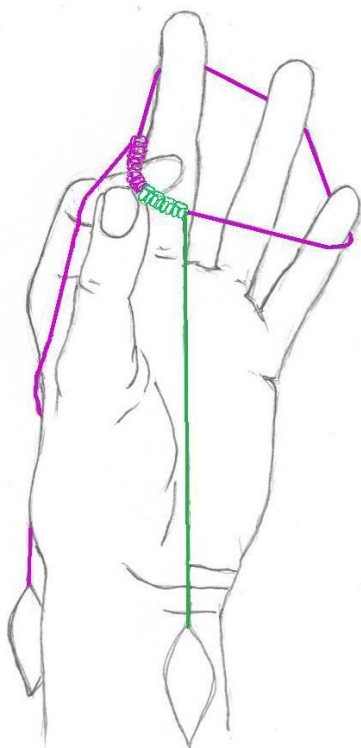


Half Moon Split Ring (HMSR)

1. Tat the 1st half of split ring as usual.



2. Bend your hand to achieve “dead spider” position. Make 2nd half of split ring using direct stitch order wrapping (see [instructions for Direct Stitch Order Wrapping](#)). The number of knots in the 2nd half of Half Moon Split Ring (HMSR) is at least 2 less, than in the 1st half.

The 2nd half of HMSR can also be made using [Reverse Stitch Order Wrapping \(lark’s head knots\)](#) as it was originally described by Sabina. In this case the work should be reversed – so that the knots’ heads are oriented towards the ring center.
