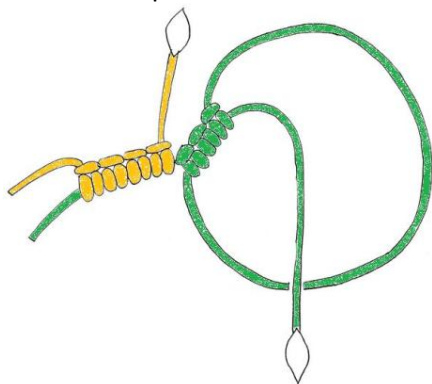
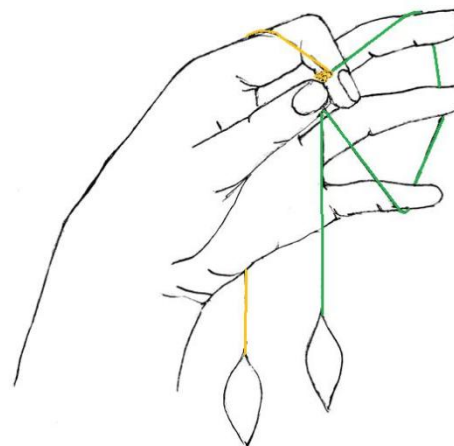
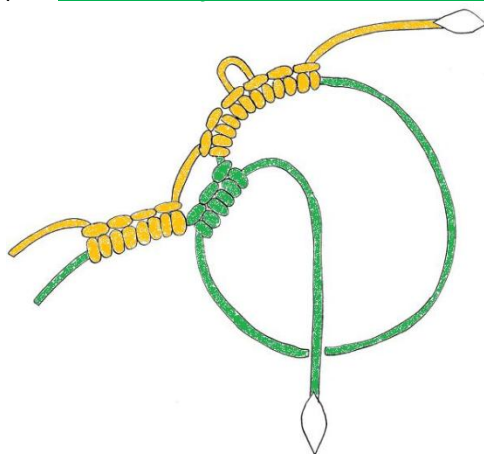


## Daisy picot (DP)

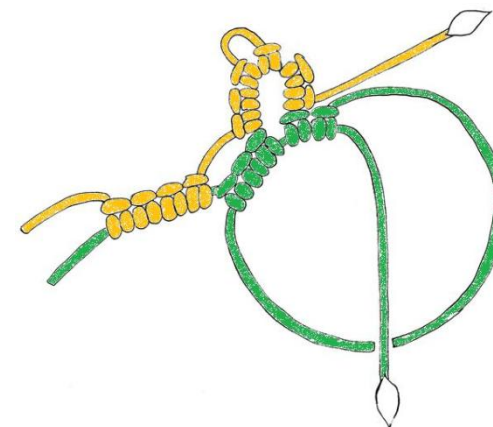
**1a.** Begin to tat ring using the core thread of the previous chain.



**2a.** Without changing hand's position make DP with direct stitch order wrapping (see [Instructions for direct stitch order wrapping](#)).

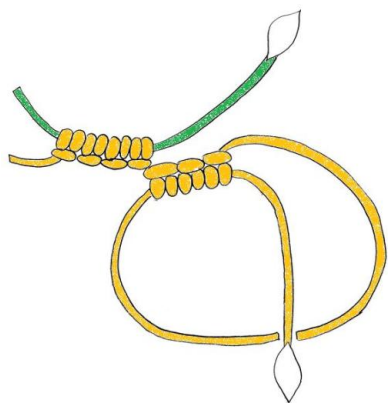


**3a.** Continue tatting ring.

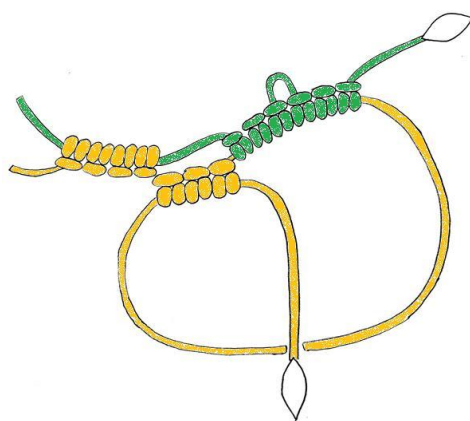


If you begin to tat ring with the working thread of the previous chain (picture 1b – 3b), it leads to other colour effects.

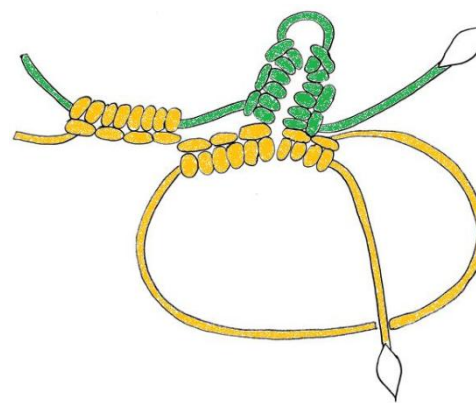

### It is important:

Do not tighten DP strongly – DP's core thread is the working thread of the ring, it may lead to compression ring's core thread or even to the flipping of the ring's knot and it will be impossible to tighten the ring!
