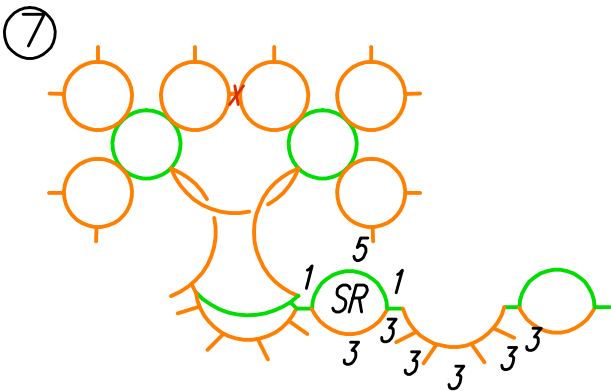
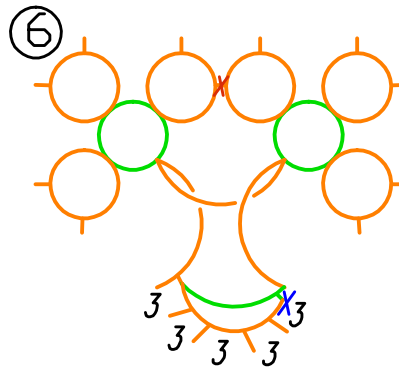
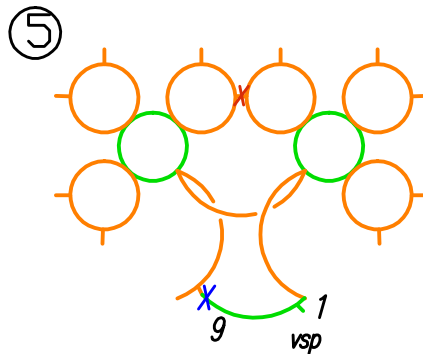
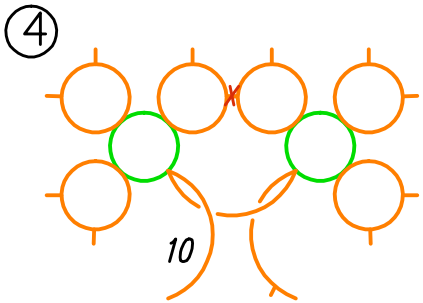
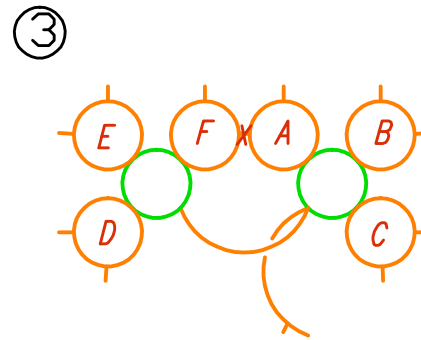
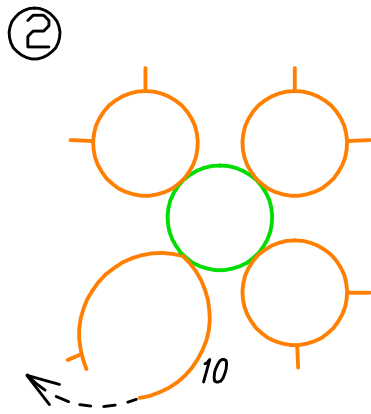
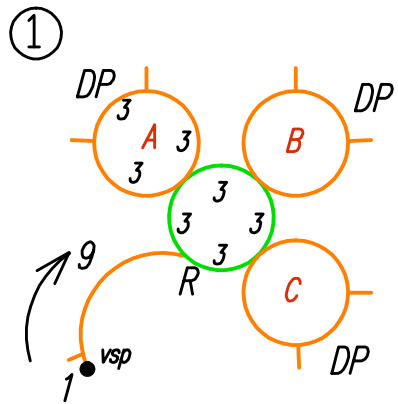


Edging with daisy picots



Abbreviations and colours:

sh1 - shuttle 1 - orange lines

sh2 - shuttle 2 - green lines

vsp - very small picot

R - ring

DP - daisy picot

A, B, C... - daisy picots' tatting order

x - locking join using working thread

x - locking join using core thread

SR - split ring

Notes:

① - ④ Tat chains and rings without reversing work

② Move the 2nd chain over the 1st one.

③ To make locking join between DP F and DP A bend the work as for making backwards join.

⑤ Reverse work before tatting a chain.

⑦ Before and after SR tat a chain with thread from sh1 as a core, consisting of 1 double knot.
