### Chains with symmetrically repeated segments, where both direct and reverse stitch order is used

Sequence, repeated throughout the chain

#### 1. 2-shuttle chains

##### 1.1. Lock chain (Lch)

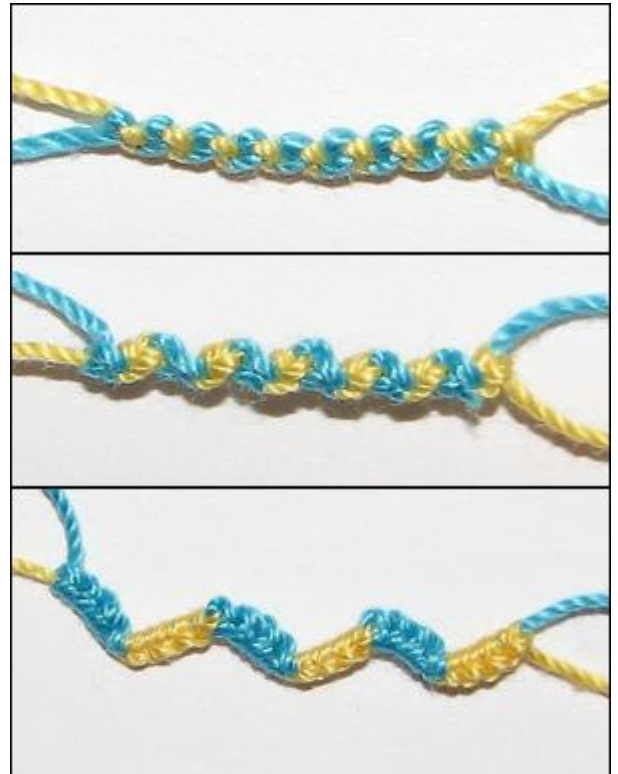
- 1) the 1<sup>st</sup> half stitch of knot, tatted with direct stitch order tatting;
- 2) the 1<sup>st</sup> half stitch of knot, made using reverse stitch order wrapping

##### 1.2. S-chain (S-sh)

- 1) double knot - direct stitch order;
- 2) double knot - reverse stitch order

##### 1.3. Z-chain (Z-ch)

- 1) certain number of double knots - direct stitch order tatting;
- 2) the same amount of double knots - reverse stitch order



#### 2. Chains in which minimum 3 threads are used – 2 wrapping threads and a core thread

##### 1.1. Pearl tatting (PT)

- 1) double knot - direct stitch order tatting with shuttle 1;
  - 2) double knot - reverse stitch order with shuttle 2.
- The core thread is the same.

##### 1.2. Josephine pearl tatting (JPT)

- 1) the 1<sup>st</sup> half stitch of knot, made with direct stitch order wrapping with shuttle 1;
  - 2) the 1<sup>st</sup> half stitch of knot, made using reverse stitch order wrapping with shuttle 2.
- The core thread is the same.
