

Abbreviations and colours:

sh1 - shuttle 1 - dark red lines

sh2 - shuttle 2 - green lines

long picots - blue lines

SR - split ring

LCh(n) – lock chain, n – number of half

stitches in each side

vsp - very small picot

ConR - connecting ring

MOR - mock onion ring

Notes:

Begin with thread of one colour on both shuttles. If you use continuos thread method, leave false picot in the beginning of the 1st chain.

and — If not using continuos thread method, hide one thread end under chain's knots (make these knots with wrapping), the other thread end tie to the sh1 or sh2 thread when you finish the lower motif and hide this end under the knots of the 2nd half of SR

6 - Tie sh1 thread to vsp and cut. Change thread on sh1 to other colour. Tat ConR: sh1 - knotting thread, sh2 - core thread.



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
